My dear Arthur

Just enjoyed our

constitutional walk after breakfast.
Dad & I felt good. Spent Sunday
afternoon in walking & gazing at
the Seeps, about 12. They were
beautiful (at the distance) as the
sun shone on them. I would prefer
them at a distance.

Last night the orchestra gave
us a wonderful program of
classical music & such a generous
program - Both pleasant.

Larimore where among the many selections, also at
dinner time gave us selections from the Opera,
which was well rendered. The Pianist & Violinist are
Artist, Pianist also playing on their own instruments.
The weather is cloudy thro a. m. but quite so many
promenading, there are white caps - & the boat
gives us gentle swaying & I hope I will be able to be on
deck everyday. There are several kind of amusements
that you could think of, which is entered into &
all goes with great deal of spirit. Also Librarian & Librarian
quite a little. But is feeling better but doubts that
he will stay in Barnstable six weeks. Every one
dressed just-like at home & plus winter hats. White
dresses they dressed just-like you would see in
Christiansburg - for deck in morning so many young
people have knitted suits. I think they are well.
Many people even wear their street hats. It's all just as
you like, & I like it - that way. Tenard calls us
hour before Breakfast. Bugle sound calls about half-
hour before Breakfast. Lunch Bugle calls once for
Lunch time, about 11.0 - on Boulevard is served on deck.

6 o.c. Bugle calls to dress for dinner, & call again
6:30. to eat. At 3 o.c. Steward sets all the tables
in drawing rooms, lunch cloth & pretty china, &
silver tea sets, & you sit around in groups & one
of the groups pour tea - & they serve four slices of
Bread & butter, raisin Bread, wafers - a Cake, they change
it every day or two, so you see times pass by rapidly
Eating - walking - writing - napping - eating, sleeping
& - After dinner we walk again, visit some, & then
at times for entertainment to ~~music~~ night Picture
show. Dance tomorrow I guess, one night-Carnival.
