

Christ Dahl, 85, Buried Tuesday

Funeral services were conducted Tuesday at the Crary Lutheran church for Christ P. Dahl, 85, who died at the home of his son-in-law and daughter, Mr. and Mrs. Rudolph Haugen, near Crary.

Rev. L. B. Braake of Lakota and Rev. L. A. Hatadt of Petersburg officiated and burial was made in the Crary cemetery.

He was born in Norway January 11, 1856, and following his marriage he came to the United States with his wife in 1879. They made their home at Dalton, Minn., and in 1883 moved to North Dakota taking up a homestead near Crary. They owned and operated this farm until 1920 when they retired and moved to Crary.

During the past year and a half they made their home with their son-in-law and daughter, Mr. and Mrs. Haugen.

Survivors include his widow and four children, Mrs. Haugen, Mrs. Simon Brein, I. C. Dahl and Alfred Dahl, all residing in the Crary community.

Active pallbearers were six grandsons, Stephen Dahl of Fargo, Manuel Dahl of Rugby, Clarence Dahl of Minneapolis, Alvin Haugen of Montevideo, Minn., and Carsten and Raymond Brein of Moorhead, Minn.
