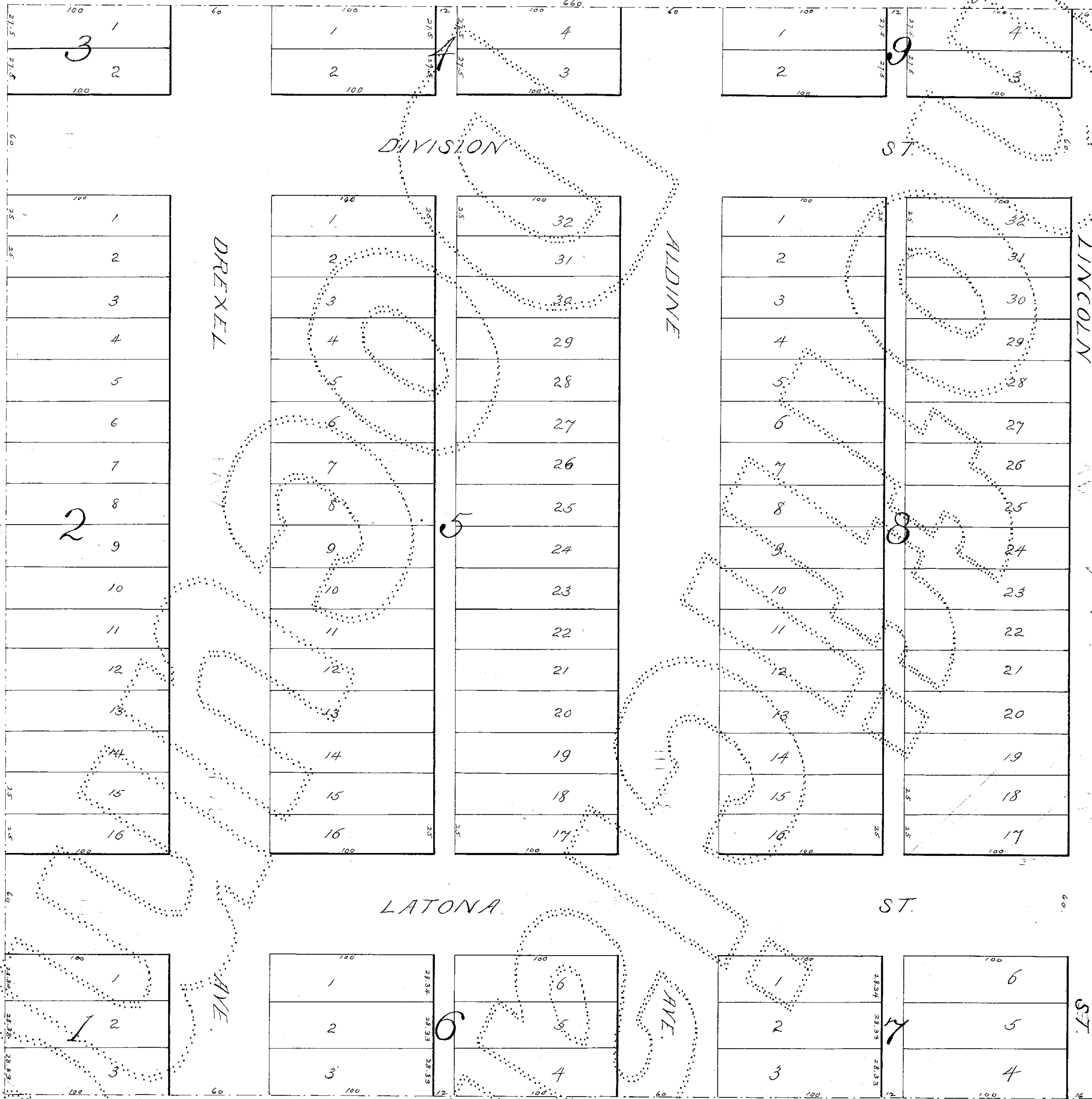


PLAT OF RANDELL'S ADDITION TO THE CITY OF SEATTLE

DESCRIPTION
 This Randell's Addition to Seattle, embraces tracts 83 and 86 of the Seattle Homestead Association 5 acre tracts further described as follows: Beginning at the 1/4 Sec. Cor. on the east side of Section 33, Twp. 25 N. R. 4 East; Thence along said east line of section 33, North 330 feet; thence East 660 feet, to the place of beginning and south-west corner of the tracts herein described. Thence North, 660 ft. - thence East 660 ft. - thence South 660 ft. - thence West, 660 feet to place of beginning - The north-east corner of Block 1 is 100 feet East and 85 feet North of the south-west corner of above described tract. All bearings are referred to the east line of Sect. 33, which is considered a true meridian. Lots 25 x 100 feet or as indicated on plat. Streets 60 feet wide or as shown on plat. Alleys 12 ft wide.
