


Plat of Randell's 2nd. Addition To the city of Seattle.

DESCRIPTION.

This Addition embraces tracts 85 and 88 of the "Seattle Homestead Association 5 acre tracts", further described as follows:

Beginning at a point 660 ft. north of the 4th Sect. cor. on the east line of Sect. 33, Twp. 25 N. R. 4 E. W. M.

Thence North 660 ft. - thence East 660 ft. - thence South 660 ft. - thence West 660 ft. to place of beginning.

The SW cor. of lot "B" blk. "14" is 30 ft. east and 660 ft. north of the 4th Sect. cor. on the east line of Section 33. - All Bearings are referred to said Sect. line which is considered a true Meridian.

Lots are 25 x 100 ft. or as indicated on plat. - Streets 60 ft. or as shown on plat.


