Be it remembered, that WILHELM GENZLER then residing at number 1021-Pearl Street, ^{City} Seattle ^{State} Washington ^{Territory of} Washington, who previous to ^{his} her naturalization was a subject of ^{citizen} Poland, having applied to be admitted a citizen of the United States of America pursuant to law, and at a November term of the U. S. District Court of Western District of Washington, held at Seattle, on the 25th day of November, in the year of our Lord nineteen hundred and twenty-two, the court having found that the petitioner had resided continuously within the United States for at least five years and in this ^{State} District for at least one year immediately preceding the date of the filing of ^{his} her petition, and that said petitioner intends to reside permanently in the United States, had in all respects complied with the law in relation thereto, and that he was entitled to be so admitted, it was thereupon ordered by the said court that he be admitted as a citizen of the United States of America.

In testimony whereof the seal of said court is hereunto affixed on the 25th day of November, in the year of our Lord nineteen hundred and twenty-two, and of our Independence the one hundred and forty-seventh.
